

We will have a **short meeting on November 4th** after the first Service (about 9:45). Grab your coffee and/or breakfast (preschool parents are serving) and meet at the back tables in the Fellowship Hall. We need to vote on where our Mission Money goes - the past few years we have been giving \$500.00 to each of the following: Lutherans

Outdoors (camps), Lutheran World Relief, and Global Health Ministries. Three wonderful Missions, although we are also open to suggestions. Answer: a Purr-maid. Money Makers coming up include a Cinnamon Roll Sale and hosting the Northern Plains Spring Gathering. Cinnamon Roll Sale is generally 20 dozen rolls and they sell well. YEA! and Thanks to our Good Shepherd Congregation Members and friends!

We need to elect officers for the next 2 years. It is preferable to elect people who will be here year round and who are willing to participate in the activities of WELCA, including when possible, attending WELCA meetings for Good Shepherd and Northern Plains Fall and Spring Gatherings. These elections do NOT change those who coordinate our various small groups within Good Shepherd, ie Quilters, Circles, Prayer groups, Altar Guild... Nominations will be open for: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Missions, Nominations Committee. Current officers are listed in the WELCA booklet. Copies can be obtained in the kiosk or at the church office. At this time we have only one yearly meeting. Most business can be done through email and phone calls. Please prayerfully consider who (including yourself) would help Good Shepherd women move forward in Mission!

The Northern Plains Spring Gathering will be on March 30th (storm date April 6) and we will be hosting. We will need women to help show women from other churches where our break out meetings are held and find their way back to the Sanctuary several times (& to bathrooms). We also will be providing and serving lunch which is where the money comes in. Good Shepherd WELCA gets \$7.00 for each person registered for lunch. So the more we have donated to the lunch menu, the more money we make for Missions. A lunch will also be required for the Winter Board meeting January 5th (storm Date Jan 12) which plans the Spring Luncheon - usually about 12 people. Officers & Spring Luncheon Committee members are asked to come to the Winter Board Meeting to help in planning. There will be anywhere from 40 to 60 women attending the Spring Gathering.

This has involved interviews with all Good Shepherd staff and revisiting the most recent surveys that have been done in the past. Creating a new survey would take several weeks of valuable time, and likely give the same information.

Once we submit the Site Profile, the next step will be a visit from the Synod, which is scheduled for **November 12th at 6:30PM** in the Fellowship Hall, to talk about our responses and get ready to post our information for prospective candidates to view. All congregational members are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting. Pie and refreshments will be served. Please do contact any committee member to visit about concerns, questions, or other input you may have.


