## Little Lambs Preschool







Creating a new survey would take several weeks of valuable time, and likely give the same information.

Once we submit the Site Profile, the next step will be a visit from the Synod, which is scheduled for **November 12<sup>th</sup> at 6:30PM** in the Fellowship Hall, to talk about our responses and get ready to post our information for prospective candidates to view. All congregational members are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting. Pie and refreshments will be served. ## From the Evangelism Board





Do you have the desire to become more involved during our worship services, but hesitate because of not knowing the procedure? We would love to have YOU join our team of ushers.


